



North Inch Renaissance Faire Terms & Conditions

Terms and Conditions of Entry

By purchasing a ticket to, entering, or participating in the North Inch Renaissance Faire, all attendees, participants, vendors, performers, and volunteers agree to the following Terms and Conditions.

1. Nature of the Event

The North Inch Renaissance Faire is a family-friendly, historically immersive event designed to transport guests to a Renaissance-era atmosphere. The Event prioritises:

- Historically inspired dress and conduct
- Limited visible modern technology
- Educational and cultural enrichment

While every effort is made to create a historically inspired experience, the event is a modern public gathering and is subject to contemporary safety regulations and laws.

2. Code of Conduct

All attendees agree to:

- Conduct themselves respectfully toward staff, performers, vendors, volunteers, and fellow guests.
- Refrain from harassment, discrimination, aggressive behaviour, or disruptive conduct.
- Follow all instructions given by event staff, stewards, or security personnel.
- Respect the immersive nature of the event by minimising visible modern items where possible.

The Organisers reserve the right to remove any individual from the event without refund for behaviour deemed inappropriate, unsafe, or inconsistent with the spirit of the Faire.

3. Family-Friendly Policy – Strictly No “Not Suitable for Work” (NSFW) Content

The North Inch Renaissance Faire maintains a **zero-tolerance policy** toward:

- Nudity or partial nudity
- Sexually explicit costumes or props
- Sexual content, gestures, or language
- Inappropriate behaviour toward minors
- Distribution or display of explicit materials

All costumes must be suitable for a general audience, including children. The organisers reserve sole discretion in determining appropriateness.

4. Costume & Prop Guidelines

We encourage Renaissance-inspired attire. However:

- All weapons (real or replica) must comply with local law.
- Prop weapons must be peace-tied or inspected if required.
- No firearms are permitted.
- No live steel combat outside of sanctioned demonstrations.
- No dangerous or hazardous materials.

The Organisers may deny entry to any costume or prop deemed unsafe or inappropriate.

5. Limited Technology Policy

To preserve immersion:

- Guests are encouraged to limit visible modern technology.
- Mobile phones should be used discreetly.
- No amplified modern music outside official programming.
- Drones are strictly prohibited unless authorised in writing.

Event staff may request that disruptive modern devices be put away.

6. Assumption of Risk

By attending the Event, you acknowledge and accept that:

- The Event may include live performances, staged combat demonstrations, animals, uneven ground, loud noises, and open-air conditions.
- Weather conditions may vary.

- Crowds may form in certain areas.
- You may encounter historically inspired activities including demonstrations of period crafts, armour, or mock combat.

You voluntarily assume all risks associated with attending the event, including risk of injury, illness, property damage, or loss.

7. Health & Safety

Attendees agree to:

- Exercise reasonable caution at all times.
- Supervise children at all times.
- Not enter restricted areas.
- Report hazards or incidents to Event staff immediately.

Anyone appearing intoxicated, disorderly, or posing a safety risk may be removed.

8. Animals

- Service animals are permitted in accordance with applicable law.
- Pets are not allowed.
- Guests are responsible for the behaviour and welfare of their animals at all times.

9. Vendors & Performers

All vendors and performers must:

- Comply with applicable laws and safety standards.
- Maintain appropriate insurance if required.
- Ensure all goods and performances are family-friendly.
- Follow all setup, teardown, and operational guidelines issued by organisers.

Failure to comply may result in removal without refund.

10. Photography & Media Release

The event may be photographed or recorded. By attending, you grant the organisers permission to use photographs, video, or audio recordings in which you may appear for promotional, archival, or marketing purposes without compensation. If you do not wish to appear in media, please notify event staff upon arrival.

11. Ticketing & Refund Policy

- Tickets are non-refundable unless the event is cancelled.
- The event may proceed in adverse weather unless conditions are deemed unsafe.
- The organisers reserve the right to modify programming as necessary.

12. Force Majeure

The organisers are not liable for cancellation, delay, or modification due to events beyond reasonable control, including but not limited to extreme weather, public health concerns, government restrictions, or emergency circumstances.

13. Liability Limitation

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the organisers, staff, volunteers, sponsors, and venue shall not be liable for:

- Personal injury
- Property damage
- Theft or loss
- Indirect or consequential damages

Nothing in these terms excludes liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence where such exclusion is prohibited by law.

14. Compliance with Law

All attendees must comply with:

- Local laws and regulations
- Venue rules
- Applicable US safety standards

Illegal activity will result in immediate removal and possible referral to authorities.

15. Agreement

Entry to the North Inch Renaissance Faire constitutes full acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. If you do not agree, please do not attend the Event.
